

Bruce L. Roth, P.E. – Mt. Washington Landslide

On April 8th, 2014, at about 4:30 in the morning, a landslide occurred on the north facing slopes of Mount Washington down slope of the businesses along Grandview Avenue and east of the Duquesne Incline. An estimated 500,000 cubic yards of material was mobilized during the landslide that covered the Norfolk Southern (NS) railroad tracks and temporarily closed rail traffic. GAI was contacted by the City of Pittsburgh to view the landslide and to provide assistance with developing a plan of action.
